



“Mirror, Mirror” – This impactful but simple illustration using some wacky, science mirrors helps kids understand how earth as it is now, is not how God originally intended it to be. This illustration looks at 1 Corinthians 13:12 and Revelation 21:1-4 to contrast life on earth and how life will be in Heaven!

Each small group of 8-10 children will need:

- Convex/Concave Mirror* (Item can be reused.) or
- Economy Version: Shiny, Large, Metal Spoon (The scooping side of a spoon is concave. The outside of a spoon is convex.)

** = Indicates special item to be purchased*

Tips for Success: (1) The concave mirror demonstration causes images appear upside down. Adult leaders may need to hold the mirror about 1 meter from a student for the student to be able see their own image upside down. (2) Consider mounting the mirror on a table and have students stand in front of the mirror, moving forward or backwards until their image appears. Modeling clay works as a great mounting agent.
