### ***"Let it Grow, Let it Grow, Let it Grow" - Instant Snow***

1. Read Isaiah 1:18. What color does God use describe our sins? What color does God use to describe what our sins will become through forgiveness?
2. Place half a tube of Instant Snow in the bottom of a Styrofoam cup. Fill a second Styrofoam cup with warm water. With one fast motion pour the water into the cup holding the powder.
3. Over a plate or paper towel, dump out the contents of the cup and explore.
4. Read Romans 10:13. According to this verse, how is it that someone becomes "saved"? What role does prayer play in someone becoming saved?
5. Read 1st John 1:9. What do we need to do to be cleansed us from our sins and become whiter than snow, as described in Isaiah 1:18?
6. Have you ever confessed to God your sins and asked Jesus to forgive you of your sins? Your sins, which are red and bad, can become white as snow through Jesus. Talk to your leader if you are interested in being sure your sins are forgiven.
7. If you have already asked Jesus to forgive you of your sins, trust that He has forgiven you. Is it important to confess your sins to God even if you are already a Christian? Discuss with your group. Read Matthew 6:9-13, The Lord's Prayer. What does this say about us asking for forgiveness of sins even after we have a relationship with God?



**The Main Point:** God turns our sins as white as snow...just ask Him for forgiveness!
