Thank you for your interest in partnering with KidMin Science to bring the GOOD NEWS of the gospel to your community.

We all entered ministry to kids to make an eternal impact. Yet there are so many competing voices, so many competing messages and so many things to distract. I entered ministry to not only make a difference but to do it in a fun way! I want to provide ministry opportunities that captivate kids and families AND engage volunteers.

Science seems to cut through the clutter and capture the attention of human curiosity. Using science in ministry is a powerful strategy to have fun, keep it simple and reach people.

In the 10+ years that I've been doing science ministry, I have worked with HUNDREDS of churches across the country — big, small and everything in between. In my 10 years working as a full-time children's pastor, I personally went from managing a team comprised of almost exclusively volunteers with virtually no budget for events, to leading a team of 6 staff members and regularly hiring outside performers to come to our church's largest outreach event. I'm not exaggerating when I say I've seen it all.

If the Lord is directing you to reach your community with the good news of Jesus Christ through an exciting and winsome event, then we can agree that He will provide the way – regardless of what your budget spreadsheet says!

If hosting an event is not something that you have a budget line item for, we want to offer you some creative and effective ways to partner with those in your church or your community to make this happen!

We know that community outreach is only ONE of the MANY hats children's ministry leaders wear. If there is anything we can do to support you in developing a plan to underwrite your event, please ask!

FINANCIAL PARTERSHIPS



- Consider asking ministry leaders from the churches in your community if they would like to partner with you in hosting one large event for the entire community. Each church would not only contribute financially, but you would also share the load providing event volunteers and have many voices to spread the word about this event. One additional benefit to a group approach to hosting a unique event like this is that it will often get the attention of small-town newspapers or Christian media outlets in larger markets.
- With the support of your pastor, send an email to key leaders in your church your elder board, deacon board, lead children's ministry volunteers or whoever else you would identify as engaged church members with a heart for spreading the gospel. Include the digital brochure to really capture their attention and let them learn more about the ministry of science and share the financial need to bring in the event.
- Depending on the budget structure of your church, talk with your outreach or mission team about using designated funds to support this event. This is truly an outreach event! We provide high quality graphics and promotional materials making it easy for you and your church members to invite the community! Science is fun for everyone but it is particularly appealing to dads, teens and those with no church interest at all. Throughout the show, the gospel is presented in a clear and bold way. This isn't an event to serve kid's ministry in your church this is an event to serve your community using your kid's ministry staff, volunteers and families!
- Pursue one "presenting sponsor" who could sponsor the event in exchange for publicity. If you know of one business within your church or in your community that you think could fund the event, consider approaching them first and asking for the full amount needed in exchange for a verbal thank you at the event, thank you signage at the event, and/or business information or promotional items distributed to guests. There are many different ways you could create a mutually beneficial arrangement for your church and the business just be open about your heart for the event and your need and come up with some ideas together.
- Instead of asking just one sponsor, use the digital brochure and reach out to all business owners within your church or connections you have within the community. You can decide how much you want to share, but it's generally helpful if people know what "goal" they are working toward. You could share with the businesses how much you are hoping to raise in order to host the event, or even give a suggested amount that you'd appreciate them donating. Use the digital brochure to share about the event, and be lovingly open and gracious in expressing your need.

FUNDRAISING EVENTS



As a children's ministry leader, you are probably no stranger to fundraising events! When choosing a fundraising event, you'll want to plan for something that is simple and easy to execute, yet engaging and appealing to those who will donate. Below are three fairly simple suggestions — that also leave lots of room for promoting and creating excitement for the upcoming science event!

Host a pancake breakfast bar before or between church services. A breakfast meal can be very inexpensive to prepare and easy for teenagers and parents to help with. Contact grocery stores or local businesses to donate as much of the product needed as possible – including paper products and serving items. Use graphics and signage to let people know what the fundraiser is for. Consider making it extra fun by having volunteers wearing lab coats, goggles, etc. and having you or another leader really go all out in a "crazy scientist" outfit to set the mood and add excitement. (You could do many different things – chili or spaghetti dinner, pizza night, etc. If possible, host your event right before/ after an event at your church or close to your church to help drive traffic to the meal event.)

Host a Parents Night Out at your church. Ask high school students and some adults to volunteer as babysitters, and families can drop their kids off for babysitting during a 2-3 hour window. Give a suggested amount for donating per kids or per family and consider sharing the total goal amount you are hoping to raise. To add to the excitement for the event, consider having the kids make a simple science craft during the babysitting night.

Create a "bug eating challenge." Purchase edible bugs from Educational Innovations (1-888-912-7474 or teachersource.com). Yes! This really is a thing! Share with your church body about this upcoming event and the money you are trying to raise. One way to do the challenge would be to tell the members that the lead pastor or head children's ministry staff will eat a bug at the end of the sermon on a certain upcoming date IF they are able to raise your goal amount by that date. Create a really fun "bug" bucket covered in plastic bugs on display for people to make their donations. Another idea is to create a competition among 3-5 church staff or children's ministry leaders. Have a separate bug donation bucket for each of the challengers, and people get to "vote" for who will eat the bug by putting money in that bucket. You get to keep ALL the donations, but only the person who got the most "votes" has to eat the bug. The competitive challenge can fuel extra donations, and maybe even some donationsby the challengers or friends of challengers to buy their way out of having to eat the bug!
