



“Take that Message and Run with It!” – Students explore the wonders of chromatography while learning about the Great Commission given by Jesus in Matthew 28 and Acts 1:8. This powerful visual inspires us to go to Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the Ends of the Earth.

Each small group of 8-10 children will need:

- 70% Rubbing Alcohol (50-60 drops needed per small group.)
- Various Colors of Permanent Markers (Items are reused.)
- 4”x4” White Cotton Cloth Swatch (1 per each small group.)
- Dropper Bottle (Item is reused.)

Tips for Success: (1) After the marker dots have been added, ask 2-3 adult leaders to hold the ends of the cloth as drops of alcohol are dripped onto the center of the cloth where the dots have been added. (2) Show leaders a completed version at a leader meeting, and consider demonstrating the process! (3) This experiment can be done on a large cotton bed sheet and all groups add to this one large sheet.
